

















KISHORE VAIGYANIK PROTSAHAN YOJANA (KVPY)-2018

KVPY is an on-going National Program of Fellowships in Basic Sciences, initiated and funded by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, to attract exceptionally motivated students to pursue research career in science.

The objectives of the program are to identify the students with talent and aptitude for research, help them realize their potential in their studies, encourage them to take up research career in science and ensure the growth of the best scientific minds for research and development in the country. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- *Stream SA: Students enrolled in the XI Standard (Science subjects) during the academic year 2018 19 and have secured a minimum of 75% (65% for SC/ST/* & PWD) marks in aggregate in MATHEMATICS and SCIENCE subjects in the X Standard Board Examination are eligible to appear for the Aptitude Test.

 The fellowship of the students selected under this stream will be activated only if they join an undergraduate course in Basic Sciences (B.Se./B.S./B.Stat./B. Math./Int. M.Sc./ Int. M.S.) in the academic year 2020-21 after having secured a minimum of 60% (60% for SC ST/WD) marks in aggregate in Science subjects in the XI Standard /(+2) Board Examination. During the interim period of one year, they will be invited for National Science (Vijvoshi) Campa and their travel expenses and local hospitality will be met by KVPY.

 Stream SX: Students enrolled in XII Standard (+2) (Science subjects) during the academic year 2018-19 and aspiring to join undergraduate program in Basic Sciences (B.Sc./B.S./B.Stat/B. Math./Int. M.Sc./Int. M.S.) for the session 2019-20 and having secured a minimum of 75% (65% for SC/ST/PWD) marks in aggregate in MATHEMATICS and SCIENCE subjects in the X Standard Board Examination are eligible to appear for the Aptitude Test. The fellowship of the students selected under this stream will be activated only if they join an undergraduate course in Basic Sciences (B.Sc./B.S./B.S. H.S. Stat./B. Math./Int. M.Sc./Int. M.S.) in the academic year 2019-20 after having secured a minimum of 60% (50% for SC/ST/PWD) marks in aggregate in Science subjects in the XII Standard /(+2) Board Examination are eligible to appear for the Aptitude fest.

 Stream SB: Students enrolled in the 1" year of B.Sc./B.S/B.Stat/B.Math./Int. M.Sc./Int. M.S. during the academic year 2018-19 and bave secured a minimum of 60% (60% for SC/ST/PWD) marks in aggregate in SCIENCE subjects in the XII Standard /(+2) Board Examination are eligible to appear for the Aptitude Test.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Applications are invited from Indian Nationals. However, as per the Interim Order (Final Order awaited) of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka, OCL/PIO Students will be allowed to write the KVPY Apstitude Test 2018.
 The KVPY (Fellowship is available to the students who have enrolled as a regular student of UG Program in Basic Science course in any College/Institution of a recognised University in India.

 A computer based online aptitude test will be conducted at all the selected cities across the country.

- a) Caste certificate issued and duly signed by the competent authority (GOI) in the prescribed proforma in the case of students belonging to SC/ST.
- b) Medical certificate from the prescribed authority in the case of physically and visually challenged students certifying the percentage of disability.

 c) Scanned Digital Photograph and Signature.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- Aptitude Test: After scrutiny of application forms, and meeting the eligibility criteria for various streams, all the eligible students will be called for a computer based online aptitude test conducted both in Hindi and English at different centers across the country on Sunday, 4" November 2018.
- (II) Interview: Based on the performance in the aptitude test, short-listed students will be invited for an interview which is the final stage of the selection procedure.

ADMIT CARD

Students may download the admit card for the aptitude test from the website from the second week of October 2018.

(II) Renewal of Fellowships

Annual renewal of fellowships will depend on the KVPY Fellows maintaining a good academic performance of first class (60% marks) or equivalent grade point average (60% or equivalent grade point average (50% or equivalent grade point average (50% or equivalent grade point average (50% for SC/ST/PWD), in Science subjects in aggregate in each academic year. It is mandatory to pass all the prescribed subjects in that particular semester of academic year and maintain 60% aggregate (50% for SC/ST/PWD). Students who failed to secure 60% marks or equivalent grade in a year (50% or equivalent grade for SC/ST/PWD) will forfeit the fellowship. However in the subsequent year if they get 60% marks or equivalent CGPA (50% or equivalent CGPA for SC/ST/PWD) in aggregate over all the previous years, the fellowship will be renewed from that year. The student is eligible to receive the KVPY fellowship up to pre-Ph.D. level or 5 years whichever is earlier. earlier.

In addition to the above, participation and satisfactory attendance in the National Science (Vijyoshi) Camp in the first year and Summer Projects every year thereafter are mandatory requirements for renewal of the fellowship.

KVPY Fellows who opt out of the Basic Sciences (B.Sc./B.S./B.Stat./B.Math./Int.M.Sc./Int.M.S.) stream at any stage will forfeit the Fellowship and Contingency Grant forthwith.

The fellowship for the students selected under the stream SA/SX/SB will be started only if they pursue an Undergraduate course in Basic Sciences that are B.Sc./B.S/B.Stat./B.Math/Int.M.Sc./Int.M.S. in Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Statistics, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Cell Biology, Ecology, Molecular Biology, Botany, Zoology, Physiology, Biotechnology, Neurosciences, Bioinformatics, Marine Biology, Geology, Human Biology, Genetics, Biomedical Sciences, Applied Physics, Geophysics, Materials Science or Environmental Science.
