Their feathers are bronze green with copper near the tips. Each feather has an eye formed by a blue, heart shaped spot. The 'eye' is surrounded by many colours. They also have a crest on top of their heads.

The peafowl is a wild bird and eats seeds, grass and insects. Peahens hide their nests in tall grass and around shrubs. The nest is a hole scratched in the grounds and lined with grass.
