- A question ends with a question mark (?)

e.g - How are you?

- We use capital letters with the names of person, place, rivers, days, months, subjects, etc.

e.g - i study in delhi public school

I study in Delhi Public School.

- To separate the words in the list we use commas (,).

e.g – I keep pencils, eraser, sharpener and scale in the box.
