- छात्र को नई शब्दों व वर्णों को सीखाना, छात्रों को स्वतंत्र रूप से पढ़ने में सक्षम बनाना ।
- छात्र द्वारा लिखित पाठ को समझना व चित्रों को पहचानना, ।
