Project

1. "World's Best Dad" Medal

Materials Needed:

- Yellow paper plate (or paint a plain one yellow)
- Black marker or black paper letters
- Decorative stickers, sequins, glitter, or pom-poms
- Strips of red or pink paper (for ribbon tails)

• Glue, Scissors, string (for hanging), Hole punch (optional).

Steps:

- 1. Prepare the Base:
 - a. Take a yellow paper plate. If it's not already yellow, paint it and let it dry.
- 2. Write the Message:
 - a. In the center of the plate, write "WORLD'S BEST DAD" using a black marker, glue and pre-cut black letters (You can take help of your mother).
- 3. Decorate the Plate:
 - a. Stick sequins, glitter, pom-poms, or stickers all around the text to make it look festive and colorful.
- 4. Make the Ribbons:
 - a. Cut two strips of red or pink paper (about 2 inches wide and 5–6 inches long).
 - b. Cut a small triangle out from the bottom of each strip to make them look like ribbon ends.
- 5. Attach the Ribbons:
 - a. Flip the plate over and glue or tape the ribbons to the bottom edge at the back so they hang down.
- 6. Make a small hole at the top of the plate. Thread a string through the hole and tie a knot to make a loop for hanging.

2. My Little Kindness Garden

Materials Needed:

- Small pots or recycled containers
- Soil
- Quick sprouting seeds (mustard, fenugreek, coriander)
- Watering can or small cup
- Old newspaper (for workspace)
- Stickers or decorations (optional)

- Plant the Seeds fill pot with soil, plant seeds, water gently.
 Name the Plant give your plant a special name.
 Daily Care water and observe growth each day.
 Creative Time decorate the pot.
