





2:- PREVENT LITTERING AND DISPOSE GARBAGE APPROPRIATELY




3:- SORT YOUR GARBAGE



TOPIC- LET US CLEAN UP JAMMU



“You can see how polluted it is here,” said 11-year-old Zakir, pointing at piles of litter along a stretch of the Tawi river in the city of Jammu. “I want this area to be clean and trees to be planted.” He grappled with a twisted mess of plastic waste and put it into a bag.

Heaps of plastic, cloth and other solid waste lay around the sides of the concrete flood barrier at Gujjar Nagar, a locality in the winter capital of Jammu and Kashmir in north-west India.



The Tawi is a transboundary river and major tributary of the Chenab, which flows from India to Pakistan. It originates at the Kailash Kund glacier in the district of Doda and passes through Jammu. Over the years, its water quality has deteriorated due to the dumping of waste and discharge of

the city's sewerage into it. In addition, climate change has [reduced its water flow](#).



According to [the annual report](#) from Jammu and Kashmir's Pollution Control Board on municipal solid waste management for 2019-20, Jammu Municipal Corporation collects waste in 77% of its wards. There is almost no waste segregation, and rubbish is disposed of in open dumpsites.



“The sewage treatment plants cannot function properly since the drainage system has less water and more waste in the form of plastic,” said Bhushan Parimoo, a Jammu-based environmentalist and chairman of Environment Awareness Forum, an NGO based in Jammu and Kashmir. He added that the stretch between Panjtirthi and Bhagwati Nagar in Jammu, downstream of Gujjar Nagar, is the main culprit of a lot of pollution in the Tawi. Parimoo also commented that the authorities involved lack vision and have no in-depth ideas on how to protect the river.





1)HEAP OF GARBAGE

Overflowing waste causes **air pollution and respiratory diseases**. One of the outcomes of overflowing garbage is air pollution, which causes various respiratory diseases and other adverse health effects as contaminants are absorbed from lungs into other parts of the body. It is very necessary to clean these heaps by municipal corporations or u can too.



2) PITS FILLED WITH STAGNANT WATER

- **Malaria and dengue** are among the main dangers of stagnant water, which can become a breeding ground for the mosquitoes that transmit these diseases. Stagnant water can be dangerous for drinking because it provides a better incubator than running water for many kinds of bacteria and parasites. Moist environments provide the perfect breeding ground for bacteria. Some varieties of bacteria are dangerous to humans and animals, and drinking stagnant water or even touching it and not washing your hands could make you, your pets, or your children very sick. **Use rags or towels** to clean up small pits of standing water. For big pits use buckets or even mugs.

IMPORTANCE OF SWATCHH BHARAT ABHIYAN

- Swachh Bharat Abhiyan was launched by the Government of India to **solve the problems of sanitation and waste management in India by ensuring hygiene across the country.**
- The main aim of the project is to create sanitation facilities for all and provide every rural family with a toilet by 2019.
- Mahatma Gandhi rightly said, “Sanitation is more important than independence”.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has directly linked clean India with the economic health of the country. This mission has provided a source of employment to many people, contributed to the GDP growth, and reduced health costs to an extent.

- There is no doubt that cleanliness is interlinked with the country's tourism and global interests.
- More tourism will bring more revenue.
- It is important for India to display high standards of hygiene and cleanliness to change the overall global perception people have about our country.
- India is home to the world's second largest population.
- This mission is the biggest social initiative taken up by the Government of India to enhance hygiene standards.
- The movement has helped in cleaning up the streets, roads, and infrastructure in many cities, small towns, and rural areas of India.
- High-levels of advocacy have helped in reducing open defecation and promote building household owned and community owned toilets.
- This has risen the hygiene and sanitation standards in the country.

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan

- Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is a **national level campaign by the Government of India** covering 4041 statutory towns to clean the streets, roads and infrastructure of the country.
- This campaign was officially launched on 2 October 2014 at Rajghat, New Delhi, where Prime Minister Narendra Modi himself wielded broom and cleaned a road.
- The campaign is India's biggest ever cleanliness drive and 3 million government employees and schools and colleges students of India participated in this event.
- The mission was started by Narendra Modi, the Prime Minister of India, nominating nine famous personalities for this campaign, and they take up the challenge and nominate nine more people and so on (like the branching of a tree). It has been carried forward since then with famous people from all walks of life joining it.



- **Shri Anant Khasbardar of Kolhapur, Maharashtra** has designed the Logo while Ms. Bhagyasri Sheth of Rajkot, Gujarat provided the tagline for the Logo.
- Spectacles of Mahatma Gandhi with its bridge in the Tricolour signifies, the nation uniting to achieve the vision of Mahatma for a clean India.
- A slew of cities and states have grabbed the center's Swachh Survekshan Awards, presented by President Ram Nath Kovind on Saturday. In the annual award ceremony, **Indore** stood as the cleanest city of the country while Chhattisgarh became bagged the title of 'cleanest states in India' for this year.

JAMMU

- *Jammu is the winter capital of the Indian union territory of Jammu and Kashmir. It is the headquarters and the largest city in Jammu District of this union territory. Lying on the banks of the riverTawi the city of Jammu, with an area of 240 km² (93 sq mi),^[3] is surrounded by theHimalayas in the north and the Northen PLains in the south. Jammu is the second most populous city of the union territory.*
- *Known as the City of Temples for its ancient temples and Hindu shrines, Jammu is the most visited place in the union territory. Jammu city shares its borders with the neighbouring Samba District .*

Etymology


- According to local tradition, Jammu is named after its founder, Raja Jamblochan, who is believed to have ruled the area in the 9th century. The local tradition holds the city to be 3000 years old but this is not supported by historians.

History

- *According to Tarikh-i-Azim Jammu came into existence around 900 CE. The state of Durgara (modern forms "Duggar" and "Dogra") is also attested from around this time. The capital of the Durgara state at that time is believed to have been Vallapura (identified with modern Bilawar). Its rulers are repeatedly mentioned in Kalhana's Rajatarangni. Babbapura (modern Babor) is another state mentioned in Rajatarangini, some of whose rulers occur in the Vamshavali (family chronicles) of later Jammu rulers. These rulers are believed to have enjoyed almost independent status and allied themselves with the Sultans of Delhi. Raja Bhim Dev is prominently mentioned in the Delhi chronicles as a supporter of Mubarak Shah (r. 1421–1434).*

- *Jammu is mentioned by name in the chronicles of Timur (r. 1370–1406), who invaded Delhi in 1398 and returned to Samarkand via Jammu. In the Mughal chronicles of Babur in the early 16th century, Jammu is mentioned as a powerful state in the Punjab hills. It is said to have been ruled by Manhas Rajputs.*

Emperor Akbar brought the hill kingdoms of the region under Mughal suzerainty, but the kings enjoyed considerable political autonomy. In addition to Jammu, other kingdoms of the region such as Kishtwar and Rajauri were also prominently mentioned. It is evident that the Mughal empire treated these hill chiefs as allies and partners.

MODERN HISTORY

- *After the decline of the Mughal power in the 18th century, the Jammu state under Raja Dhruv Dev of the Jamuwal (Jamwal) family asserted its supremacy among all the Dugar states. Its ascent reached its peak under his successor Raja Ranjit Dev (r. 1728–1780), who was widely respected among the hill states. Ranjit Dev promoted religious freedom and security, which attracted many craftsmen and traders to settle in Jammu, contributing to its economic prosperity.*
- *Towards the end of Ranjit Dev's rule, the Sikh clans of Punjab gained ascendancy, and Jammu began to be contested by the Bhangi, Kanhaiya and Sukarchukia misls. Around 1770, the Bhangi misl attacked Jammu and forced Ranjit Dev to become a tributary. Brij Lal Dev, Ranjit Dev's successor, was defeated by the Sukerchakia chief Mahan Singh, who sacked Jammu and plundered it. Thus Jammu lost its supremacy over the surrounding Country. In 1808, Jammu itself was annexed to the Sikh Empire by Maharaja Ranjit Singh, the son of Mahan Singh.*

- *In 1818 Raja Kishore Singh, Father of Raja Gulab Singh, was appointed and anointed the ruler of Jammu Principality, hence started the Jamwal Dynasty, aka Dogra Dynasty, which came to rule the princely state of Jammu and Kashmir under British suzerainty. The rulers built large temples, renovated old shrines, built educational institutes and many more. A 43 km long Railway Line connecting Jammu with Sialkot was laid in 1897.*
- *Jammu has historically been the capital of Jammu Province and the winter capital of the princely state of Jammu and Kashmir (1846–1952).*
- *After the partition of India, Jammu continues as the winter capital of the Indian state of Jammu and Kashmir.*

- *Jammu city is the main cultural and economic centre of the administrative division of Jammu. One of the most famous local Basmati Rice is produced in the RS Pura area near Jammu, which is then processed in rice mills in Jammu. Apart from rice mills scattered all around Jammu, industrial estate at Bari Brahamna has a large presence of industrial units manufacturing a variety of products right from carpets, electronic goods, electric goods.*

- Diarrhea is among the leading killers of children, accounting for 10 per cent of all deaths amid homeless children under the age of 5, worldwide, as per the (UNICEF) and many NGO's. Dirty hands is one of the major causes of Diarrhea; children and elders both must wash their hands properly and frequently, especially before eating and encourage others to do the same.

4. Re-Use and Re-cycle

- Reuse and recycle are the two magical mantras in developing cleaner surroundings. If there is something which you don't require anymore; discover another way of using it, if not then look for someone who might need it; if it's wrecked, then try to repair it before disposing.

We can also plant more trees because they help to keep the temperature low and they provide comfort. Horns in cars and other vehicles should be low in volume and they should be used sparingly. I would even persuade my friends to be conscious of the fact that noise producing toys, electric gadgets etc should not be used. Teachers should also have a separate lecture for students on cleanliness because from that, they could learn about the biodiversity, cleanliness programs and it would also help them to enhance their learning. Government of J&K has imposed a ban on the use of polythene but everyone is still breaking the rule without any fear. Jammu Municipal Corporation should take some strict and serious steps and should send garbage trucks to pick the waste. We should make cleanliness a habit and a responsibility. Dirtiness has terrible effects on our


