

## NEWSPAPERS

The first printed newspaper of India was in English, and was called Hicky's Bengal Gazette. It was edited and published by James Augustus Hicky, an ex-employee of the East India Company. The first issue of this newspaper came out in 1780 and carried only classified advertisement on its front page. It was a weekly newspaper and it generally dealt with the arrival and departure of Europeans, timings of steamers, fashionable news from London, Paris and Vienna and personal news.

It attended to the needs of the small European community of Calcutta.
