










DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL, JAMMU CELEBRATES CHRISTMAS

beautiful festival of Christmas and Lord Jesus Christ. Then the Santa Claus arrived with jingling bells and showering gifts and goodness.








DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL, ORGANIZIES VISION TESTING CAMP FOR THE STUDENT OF PRIMARY CLASSES
